

Cowboy H.O.G. Ride to Concan 2010

*Friday September 17th – Sunday September 19th

This is a Level 3 Ride. Don't let the local weather forecast scare you off! Two years ago Hurricane Ike was supposed to deluge the area. We left as scheduled and the entire three days was rain free and beautiful!

Day 1: Depart from Cowboy Harley Davidson Austin at 9:30 A.M. for a leisurely ride through the Hill Country to Concan on the Frio River. Ride will end at Neal's Lodge. Join us in the Frio River for some relaxation and conversation. Dinner is open but there will likely be a group riding a few miles up river to the House Pasture Cattle Company. There are several other local eating establishments in the area as well as Leakey and Uvalde.

Day 2: Depart from Neal's Lodge at 9:00 A.M. for a ride across the Three Sisters, rated one of the best rides in Texas. Ride will end at the Frio Canyon Motorcycle Stop in Leaky. They have a small café if you're ready for lunch. www.friocanyonmotorcyclestop.biz

Dinner is open but we've been known to grill out at Neal's Lodge. Participants chip in to cover food cost. Stay tuned for updates.

Day 3: Depart from Neal's Lodge at 9:00 A.M. for the return ride to Fredericksburg , TX .

Depending on the interest of the group, we will take a short ride to the Lone Star Motorcycle Museum (<http://lonestarmotorcyclemuseum.com/index.html>). If there's little or no interest, we'll ride directly to the Hangar Hotel Diner (<http://www.hangarhotel.com/diner.htm>) in Fredericksburg , TX for lunch. The ride ends there.

There are many interesting things to do in Fredericksburg and the surrounding area if you aren't in a hurry to return home, i.e. antique shops, Luckenbach, LBJ Ranch, wineries, etc.

September 17th & 18th – Neal's Lodge -Concan - Contact Neal's Lodge at 830-232-6118 (Mary Anna) to make your reservations. Be sure to tell them that you are with the Cowboy chapter of Austin HOG. Each cabin is set up with a minimum of two beds, linens are provided. They will try to keep the group together across from the main office. Quoted rates are \$75 per night (1 person), and \$87.50 per night (2 person) for this area. There are cabins that overlook the river for booking as well if you prefer. In the past they have offered a 30% discount on the rate (rates vary depending on the cabin. For more information visit www.nealslodges.com.)
